## **Environment of Care Tips**

Protect residents and others - Clean surface areas frequently



## **Create a Process for Cleaning Equipment and Room Surfaces**

- Keep Resident care area neat and without clutter
- Clean high touch, high risk surfaces at least once per shift;
  Door handle, light switch, bedpan cleaners, toilet hand holds
- Build in time to wipe down/clean all equipment shared between residents;
  Stethoscope, BP Cuff, Walker
- Build surface cleaning into resident care workflow
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Wipe down bedside table and call button before and after meals
  - o Wipe down Faucet and toilet rails after assisting Resident
- Know who cleans what surfaces during each shift; EVS, nursing, therapy, etc.
  - Create a checklist with responsible person and frequency

## Use only products on the EPA N-list approved for use with COVID-19

- Have easily available when needed; in resident room, on medication cart, at nurses' station
- Know how to apply:
  - Clean surface first then apply product
  - Know the contact time product needs to remain on the surface to kill the virus
