How to Use Disability.gov - Search Examples

Disability.gov offers two ways to search for information: 1.) the "Search Box," located at the top of the home page, and 2.) the "Information by Topic" menu, located on the left side of the home page. The scenarios below provide examples of how to use both search tools to find the information you are looking for on Disability.gov.
