

INJECTION SAFETY: PREPARING YOUR BEST SHOT

- Use aseptic technique during the procedure.
- **Designate a clean medication preparation area** >3 ft. from any potential source of contamination (i.e. sink, lab area). Keep it disinfected.
- Perform hand hygiene first. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is the preferred method.
- Inspect the vial appearance & expiration date.
- **Disinfect the vial top with >70% alcohol swab** every time before piercing the vial.
- Use a new sterile needle and syringe every time.
- Never combine vial leftovers for future use.
- Date the multi-dose vials (MDVs) when opened & discard in 28 days unless manufacturer specifies an earlier date.
- Dedicate MDVs to one patient whenever possible.
- Store MDVs in the medication preparation area.
- Deem MDVs that enter a patient care area, single use only and discard after use.
