Mpox (formerly known as monkeypox) is a viral disease. The virus is mostly spread through skin-to-skin contact.

Should I get vaccinated?

Vaccination is an important tool in preventing the spread of mpox.

The JYNNEOS vaccine protects against severe illness, hospitalization, and death.



2 doses of the vaccine provide the best protection.



Anyone in Philadelphia who thinks they're likely to be exposed to mpox can get the vaccine.
