




Philadelphia Department of Public Health Seasonal Influenza Surveillance Report MMWR Week 24: June 8, 2025—June 14, 2025


Philadelphia Influenza Activity


Please note these data are provisional and subject to change.

During week 24, influenza diagnoses at local emergency departments and positive detections of influenza A at select local hospital laboratories remained low. Detections for influenza B remained low during week 24, consistent with the past several weeks. Data from all facilities are complete from Week 8 2025 forward. Twenty-nine influenza outbreaks in long-term care facilities have been reported and confirmed (≥ 1 case of laboratory confirmed flu reported in a long-term care facility) so far this season.









Pennsylvania

As of June 14, 2025 the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH) has paused their respiratory virus summaries due to low activity. Activity levels in PA are based on laboratory confirmed influenza cases. United States

As of June 14, 2025, the CDC reported that influenza activity remains low. In week 24, clinical laboratories reported 275 (1.2%) of 22,898 specimens tested positive for influenza, 33.8% of which were influenza A. Of influenza A specimens subtyped at public health labs, 87.0% have been subtyped as H1N1 and 13.0% as H3N2. In week 24, all 53 jurisdictions with sufficient data reported minimal influenza activity.
