




Philadelphia Department of Public Health Seasonal Influenza Surveillance Report MMWR Week 39 September 21, 2025—September 27, 2025


Philadelphia Influenza Activity


Please note these data are provisional and subject to change.

During week 39, influenza diagnoses at local emergency departments remained low. Detections for influenza A and influenza B at select local hospital laboratories remained low during week 39, consistent with the past several weeks. Data from all facilities are complete from Week 8 2025 forward. Thirty-six influenza outbreaks in long-term care facilities have been reported and confirmed (≥ 1 case of laboratory confirmed flu reported in a long-term care facility) during the 2024-2025 season.









Pennsylvania

As of September 27, 2025 the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH) respiratory virus summaries remain paused due to low activity. Activity levels in PA are based on laboratory confirmed influenza cases.
