Philadelphia is hosting several special events this summer, including the FIFA World Cup, America250, and the MLB All-Star Game. These events will bring more visitors to our city, which can raise the chances of people getting sick or hurt.

The Health Department has developed this document to help residents and visitors stay safe, healthy, and seek care this summer in Philadelphia.

Preparedness Resources



Protect Yourself and Others

- Wash your hands often and well.
- Skip events if you are not feeling well.
- Cover coughs and sneezes.
- Protect yourself against mosquitoes and ticks.



Staying Cool during Extreme Heat

- Drink water and stay hydrated.
- Wear lightweight, light-colored, loose-fitting clothing.
- Find ways to stay cool, indoors and outside.
- Find more heat safety tips at phila.gov/heat.



Staying Informed about Air Quality

- Poor air quality days are rare in Philadelphia, but they do happen.
- Check the air quality near you in real time at phila.gov/breathephilly.
- Limit time spent outdoors on days when air quality is poor.



When, Where, and How to Seek Care

- Seek medical care when you need it.
- If you are experiencing a medical emergency, call 911.
- Visit an urgent care center for inquiries that are not emergent. Call ahead to confirm hours and availability.
- Visit a pharmacy for over-the-counter medications.
